



New playground equipment is up

The east end of Campbell Park, near the Lions picnic shelter, has taken on a new look in recent days. Volunteers and city workers constructed the new playground equipment last Friday and Saturday, southwest of the picnic shelter. Above, a look from the southwest shows the entire structure on Monday. Since then, city workers have spread pea-sized gravel over the ground underneath and its ready to be used.
