

RESOLUTION NO. R24-01-01

RESOLUTION APPROVING ELECTIC RATES

FOR THE CITY OF IMPERIAL, STATE OF NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, the City of Imperial (City), State of Nebraska, owns and operates an electric distribution system, which provides for the electric power needs of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City must recoup costs for goods and services, maintain and upgrade its electric distribution system, and must do so by the collection of fees for that commodity; and,

WHEREAS, the City retained the Nebraska Municipal Power Pool (NMPP) to complete an independent Cost of Service and Rate Design Study (Study) of the City's electric rates; and,

WHEREAS, NMPP recommends a revenue-neutral rate adjustment that would recover sufficient revenues to cover the City's expenses as well as cover costs that have occurred since the original rate plan was developed; and,

WHEREAS, the City agrees with NMPP's rate recommendations and desires to adopt the recommended rates to be effective February 2024 billing

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the governing body of the City of Imperial, State of Nebraska, that effective February 1, 2024, the electric fees/rates for the City of Imperial, State of Nebraska, are hereby established as shown on the attached rate sheets:

- Residential Service (RE)
- General Service (GS)
- Irrigation Service (IP)
- General Service Demand (GSD)
- Rural Residential Service (RRE)
- Rural General Service (RGS)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any ordinance or resolution passed, approved, and adopted prior to the passage, approval, and publication of this Resolution in conflict with its provisions is repealed as of February 1, 2024.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution are separable, and the invalidity of any phase, clause, or part of this Resolution shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of this resolution.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE (RE)

AVAILABLE: Within the corporate limits of the City of Imperial, State of Nebraska.

APPLICABLE: To single-family residences, individually metered apartments, and rooming houses for all domestic purposes when all service is supplied through a single meter. Ratings of individual single-phase motors shall not exceed ten (10) horsepower without written approval of Utility Manager. Customers desiring single meter service to multi-family units must request such service in writing. Approval will be granted only when, in the sole opinion of the Utility Manager, individual metering is not practical.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE: AC, 60 Hertz, 120/240 volt, three (3) wire, single-phase; or 120 volt, two (2) wire. Three-phase service to single family residences is not available under this rate schedule.

RATE:

For service after February 1, 2024

Customer Charge: \$23.00 per month

Monthly Energy Charges:

BILLING PERIODS: The Summer billing period is for bills rendered between June 1 and September 30 and the winter billing period is for bills rendered between October 1 and May 31.

MINIMUM BILL: The Customer Charge.

IRRIGATION SERVICE (IP)

AVAILABLE: In the general area served by the City of Imperial, State of Nebraska, for service to Irrigation Systems.

APPLICABLE: To seasonal irrigation service to Customers served from existing single or three-phase distribution lines, whose entire requirements are taken through one (1) meter, under a contract of standard form.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE: AC, 60 cycles, single or three-phase, at any of the City's standard voltages (35,000 volts or less) where the service may be supplied by a single power transformation.

RATE:

For service after February 1, 2024

Monthly Customer Charge: \$74.00 per month

Annual Fixed Charge - Uncontrolled

\$123.00 per horsepower (HP) connected per season, for all HP

Annual Fixed Charge - One (1) day per week control

\$105.00 per horsepower (HP) connected per season, for all HP

Annual Fixed Charge – Two (2) day per week control

\$88.00 per horsepower (HP) connected per season, for all HP

Annual Fixed Charge – Three (3) day per week control

\$64.00 per horsepower (HP) connected per season, for all HP

Annual Fixed Charge - Daily control

\$48.00 per horsepower (HP) connected per season, for all HP

BILLING PERIODS: The Summer billing period is for bills rendered between June 1 and September 30 and the winter billing period is for bills rendered between October 1 and May 31.

Annual Fixed Charges are billed in May of each year. A customer may request to be moved from a lower cost more frequent control group (e.g. Daily to 3 Day) in mid-season, but a customer will not be refunded any Fixed Fee charge if they request to move to a less frequent control group, (e.g. Uncontrolled to 1 Day Control)

coincident peak demand shall mean the Customer's demand occurring at the same time as that of the City's summer peak demand, June-September.

Summer Off-Peak demand shall be the difference between the total Off-Peak demand and the On-Peak billing demand, but in no case less than zero.

Winter billing demand shall be the greater of #1 or #2 below:

1. The highest measured demand (corrected for power factor, if required) during any sixty (60) minute period occurring in the current billing period.
2. Sixty-five percent (65%) of the highest measured On-Peak demand (corrected for power factor, if required) during any sixty (60) minute period occurring in June-September of the preceding eleven (11) months. For purposes of this schedule coincident peak demand shall mean the Customer's demand occurring at the same time as that of the City's summer peak demand, June-September.

METERING REQUIREMENTS:

Customers desiring Time of Use (TOU) metering for Off-Peak billing shall request said service in writing. Customers with peak demands of less than 100 kW, but greater than 25 kW, for three (3) consecutive months during the most recent twelve (12) month period, may have demand metering installed solely at the discretion of the City. All necessary metering (as defined by City) will be installed and owned by the City of Imperial.

RURAL GENERAL SERVICE (RGS)

AVAILABLE: Within established Service Area of City of Imperial, State of Nebraska, but outside the corporate limits of the City.

APPLICABLE: To any Customer for lighting, heating, and power purposes where all service is taken through a single meter at one location, and where the Customer's monthly peak demand does not exceed 100 kW, or monthly usage exceed 30,000 kWh, for three (3) consecutive months. Rating of individual single-phase motors and other single-phase power and heating units served under this schedule shall not exceed ten (10) horsepower without written approval of Utility Manager.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE: AC, 60 Hertz. 120 volts or 120/240 volts, single-phase; 120/240, 120/208 volts, or 277/480 volts, three-phase, four (4) wire; or at any of the City's standard distribution voltages, as available.

RATE:

For service after February 1, 2024

Customer Charge:	\$48.00	per month for single-phase service
	\$74.00	per month for three-phase service

BILLING PERIODS: The Summer billing period is for bills rendered between June 1 and September 30 and the winter billing period is for bills rendered between October 1 and May 31.

MINIMUM BILL: The Customer Charge.

INSTALLATION OF DEMAND METER: At the option of the City, a demand meter may be installed on any Rural General Service Customer for ascertaining loads. Customers with demands of 25 kilowatts or more for three (3) consecutive months may request service under the General Service Demand rate.
